- Offering advice and options in area of expertise
- Offering introductions and connections to Museum of Colour in your area.

- Provide opportunities for you visit rehearsals or portraits shoots, so you can see how we work
- Be responsible and careful in how we communicate with any contacts you share with us
- Name you in documents as an advisor unless you specify that we don't.
